ITEM 1. CALL MEETING TO ORDER.

ITEM 2. PLEDGE OF ALLEGIANCE AND INVOCATION.

ITEM 3. CITIZENS COMMENTS – A member of the public may inquire about a subject for which notice has not been given, any deliberation or discussion about the subject of the inquiry shall be limited to:

- (1) A proposal to place the subject on the agenda for the next subsequent meeting
- (2) A statement of specific factual information; or
- (3) A recitation of existing policy. Any further discussion into the details or questions about the subject is prohibited.

ITEM 4. REVIEW, DISCUSS, AND TAKE ACTION ON CONSTRUCTION MANAGERS AT RISK PROPOSALS FOR THE NEW COUNTY LAW ENFORCEMENT CENTER.

ITEM 5. CONSIDER REIMBURSEMENT RESOLUTION FOR THE COUNTY LAW ENFORCEMENT CENTER.

ITEM 6. TAKE ANY AND ALL NECESSARY ACTION FOR NEW LAW ENFORCEMENT FACILITY.
