**Resolution and Election Order  
Postponed Election – May 2020**

Whereas, the term of office of Trustee Daniel Hinson; and the term of office of Trustee Greg Lambert will expire on the First Saturday in May, 2020, said First Saturday being the 2<sup>nd</sup> day of May 2020 and said term of office was extended by postponement of the May 2020 Board Election due to COVID 19 by authorization of the Governor;

Now, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED AND ORDERED by the Groom Independent School District Board of Trustees, acting in open session on the 16th day of July, 2020;

**Election Order and Date**

.....(1) that an election be held in said school district for the purpose of electing to the board of trustees two (2) trustees to serve a three-year terms, said election to be held on the first Tuesday in November 2020, being the 3<sup>rd</sup> day of November 2020;

**Election Day – Polling Location and Hours and Election Judge**

.....(2) that said election shall be held in the Groom Community Center Building located at 100 Broadway, City of Groom, County of Carson, and State of Texas; and further, that the polls at the above designated polling place shall, on election day, be open from seven o'clock (7:00), A.M., to seven o'clock (7:00), P.M.; additionally, this order hereby appoints Dondra Downs as Election Judge and accordingly she is granted the authority to assign election clerks and election counters in accordance with State Law regarding such clerks and counters, with the wage for the election Judge, election clerks, and election counters to be set according to Texas State Law regarding such payments, with additional fees as required by law paid to the election judge for delivery of the ballots as authorized by Chapter 32, Section 32.092 of the Texas Election Code;

**Early Voting – Polling Location and Hours**

.....(3) that early voting for the above designated election shall be conducted in the Office of the Superintendent of Schools located at 304 West Third Street, City of Groom, County of Carson, and State of Texas, and that the said place of early voting shall remain open between the hours of 8:30 A.M. until 12:00 P.M., and 1:00 P.M. until 3:30 P.M., on each day for early voting which is not a Saturday, a Sunday, or an official State Holiday, beginning on the 21<sup>st</sup> day prior to election day, said day being on Tuesday, the 19<sup>th</sup> day of October, 2020, and continuing through the 4<sup>th</sup> day preceding election day, that day being Friday, the 30<sup>th</sup> day of October, 2020, also remaining open on Wed. October 21, 2020 and Wed. October 28, 2020 from the hours of 7:00 A.M. until 7:00 P.M., and shall further remain open for emergency voting procedures as outlined in Texas State Law, including, but not limited to, the hours of 7:00 A.M. until 7:00 P.M. on the day of the election;

**Election Judges and Early Voting Clerk**


.....(4) that election judges will be appointed and that Jennifer Peet (or her qualified replacement) is hereby appointed Early Election Clerk; and that the election judges and the early voting clerk are hereby granted the authority to assign election clerks and election counters in accordance with State Law regarding such clerks and counters, with the wage for the election Judge, election clerks, and election counters to be set according to Texas State Law regarding such payments, with additional fees as required by law paid to the election judge for delivery of the ballots as authorized by Chapter 32, Section 32.092 of the Texas Election Code;


.....(5) that the manner of conducting early voting by mail, e-mail, emergency absentee balloting, and the manner of holding said election shall be governed, as nearly as may be, by the election code of the State of Texas; and that the mailing address for the early voting clerk is P.O. Box 598, Groom, Texas 79039; e-mail for the early voting clerk is jennifer.peet@groomisd.net .
